Candidates must meet the following criteria to apply:

- A resident of the borough of Ards and North Down
- Aged over 21
- Hold a full driving licence (paper and card needed to gain HGV provisional licence to start training)
- Either unemployed, underemployed (16 hours per week or less) OR be at risk of redundancy
- Wish to upskill from a Class 1 to a Class 2
- Willing to undertake a medical exam
- Be available for training, medical, theory (three parts) and practical (1 week long intensive course)
